World Water Crisis Factsheet

- One child dies every two minutes from a preventable waterborne disease. Diarrhea causes more child deaths than violence.
- 2.2 billion people live without access to safely managed drinking water in their homes.
- Rural areas accounted for four out of five people lacking at least basic drinking water services in 2022.
- Roughly half of the world's population experiences severe water scarcity for at least part of the year. This can happen for several months, or all year long.
- 200 million hours per day are spent by women and children collecting water. Together that equates to 22,800 years.
